<u>STANDARD</u>: Written policy, procedure and practice shall define that the following staff shall be allowed to conduct face to face visits:

- The Community Supervision Agency Officer assigned to the youth
- Another Community Supervision Agency Officer that is not assigned to the youth but has current knowledge of the juvenile's circumstances
- Another staff member of the Community Supervision Agency (CSA) who actively participated in the development of the youth's supervision plan

DISCUSSION: None.

NOTE: The standards and procedures set forth herein are intended to establish operational guidelines for community supervision agencies operating through the board of county commissioners and their employees/contractors and the juvenile offenders under supervision. They are not intended to establish state created liberty interests for community supervision agencies, or the board of county commissioners, or their employees/contractors, or juvenile offenders, or an independent duty owed by the Kansas Department of Corrections- Division of Juvenile Services to community supervision agencies operating through the board of county commissioners or their employees/contractors, supervised juvenile offenders or third parties. This standard and procedure is not intended to establish or create new constitutional rights or to enlarge or expand upon existing constitutional rights or duties.
