Target Population

- Crossover Youth: A young person aged 10 and older with any level of concurrent involvement with child welfare and juvenile justice systems.
 - Involvement in the child welfare system includes:
 - Out-of-home placement, an assigned investigation of alleged abuse or neglect with a young person named as an alleged perpetrator, and/or participation in voluntary/preventative services cases that are open for services.
 - Involvement in the juvenile justice systems includes:
 - Court-ordered community supervision and Immediate Intervention Programs (IIPs).


