STANDARD: Written policy, procedure, and practice shall permit the transfer of court-ordered custody juveniles from one out-of-home placement to another out-of-home placement without prior notice or court approval. Following an out-of-home placement change, the following shall occur:

- Notification to the Court in writing as soon as the placement has been accomplished
- Notification to the parent(s)/guardian(s) as soon as possible following the placement
- Completion and distribution of the KDOC-0112

Juveniles that have been in out-of-home placement shall not be returned home without first notifying the Court of this placement.

The Protection and Prevention Services (PPS)-5460 shall be completed and forwarded pursuant to CSS-04-125 following any placement change.

DISCUSSION: None.

NOTE: The standards and procedures set forth herein are intended to establish operational guidelines for community supervision agencies operating through the board of county commissioners and their employees/contractors and the juvenile offenders under supervision. They are not intended to establish state created liberty interests for community supervision agencies, or the board of county commissioners, or their employees/contractors, or juvenile offenders, or an independent duty owed by the Kansas Department of Corrections- Division of Juvenile Services to community supervision agencies operating through the board of county commissioners or their employees/contractors, supervised juvenile offenders or third parties. This standard and procedure is not intended to establish or create new constitutional rights or to enlarge or expand upon existing constitutional rights or duties.
