STANDARD: Written policy, procedure and practice shall require that for cases in which a juvenile is placed in a licensed Foster Home, upon the Court's request for a six (6) month foster parent report, the Community Supervision Agency shall provide:

- The foster parents with a copy of the KDOC-0090 form
- At least two (2) weeks' notice to the foster parents prior to a six (6) month foster parent report being due for submission to the Court

The six (6) month time period begins upon the juvenile being placed in the foster home.
DISCUSSION: Youth sentenced pursuant to KSA 38-2361(a)(10) and placed in a therapeutic foster home are required to adhere to this standard.
