STANDARD: Written policy, procedure and practice shall state that the Community Supervision Agency shall not condone any actions by Community Supervision Agency staff that may constitute physical, emotional or sexual abuse of the juvenile. Acts include but are not limited to: sexual contact, hitting, shaking, cursing, threatening, binding, closeting, prolonged isolation, meal denial as a punishment and derogatory remarks about the juvenile and/or the juvenile's family. The Community Supervision Agency staff and/or administration shall take the proper corrective action in response to such prohibited acts, including reporting suspected abuse as required by K.S.A. 38-2223.
