<u>STANDARD</u>: Written policy, procedure and practice shall require the Community Supervision Agency to maintain a weekly work schedule for Community Supervision Agency Officers that indicates flexible workdays, hours and schedules to accommodate the needs of the juveniles.

The development of flexible Community Supervision Agency Officer and Community Supervision Agency Director schedules shall reflect the need to accommodate the schedules of youth, families and community partners. The flexible schedules shall address contact with youth and families, and address the availability of programming and groups. Thirty (30) percent of the Community Supervision Agency Officer's weekly work schedule shall be outside of the 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. timeframe. Time worked outside of the 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. timeframe shall be focused on direct service delivery with the youth and/or family.
