<u>STANDARD</u>: Written policy, procedure and practice shall prohibit Immediate Intervention Program (IIP) employees from carrying weapons in the performance of their duties. When situations cannot be resolved, law enforcement authorities shall be contacted for assistance.

The use of firearms, oleoresin capsicum (pepper spray), any variation of blunt force weapons including batons and any variation of conducted electrical weapons including Tasers shall be prohibited. State block grant funds shall not be used in the purchasing of the above stated weapons and/or any of their accessories.

This standard shall not prohibit the carrying of concealed firearms when done so in accordance with the Kansas Personal and Family Protection Act. State block grant funds shall not be used in the purchasing of firearms or accessories for concealed carry.
