<u>STANDARD</u>: Written policy, procedure and practice shall require the Intake and Assessment Program to attempt to review the intake and assessment information and the assessment results with the youth and the youth's parent(s)/guardian(s), or another appropriate person.

There may be occasions where this review is not in the best interest of the youth. In these situations, the intake and assessment information and results shall not be shared with the parent/guardian and/or appropriate adult. The Intake and Assessment Program Director or designee shall make the determination if the release of the information and results are not in the best interests of the youth.

<u>DISCUSSION</u>: Reviewing results of the intake and assessment process with the parent/legal guardian/appropriate person keeps them informed of the youth's involvement in the intake process.
