<u>STANDARD</u>: Written policy, procedure and practice shall prohibit Intake and Assessment Program employees from carrying weapons in the performance of their duties.

The use of the following items shall be prohibited for use by Juvenile Intake and Assessment staff in the performance of their duties:

- Firearms
- Oleoresin capsicum (pepper spray)
- Any variation of blunt force weapons (including batons)
- Any variation of electric control devise (including Tasers)

State block grant funds shall not be used in the purchasing of the above stated weapons and/or any of their accessories.

This standard shall not prohibit the carrying of concealed firearms when done so in accordance with the Kansas Personal and Family Protection Act which can be found at https://ag.ks.gov/docs/default-source/documents/concealed-carry-statutes.pdf?sfvrsn=d8ad9753_32. State block grant funds shall not be used in the purchasing of firearms or accessories for concealed carry.

<u>DISCUSSION</u>: When situations cannot be resolved, law enforcement authorities may be contacted for assistance.
