**STANDARD:** Written policy, procedure and practice shall require the Community Supervision Agency to have an office and field safety policy for employees.

**DISCUSSION:** The Community Supervision Agency should consider the following when determining a response to a possibly violent or dangerous situation:

- Staff safety
- Juvenile safety
- Prevention
- De-escalation
- No risk-taking
- Natural disaster
- Facility safety
- The transportation of juveniles
- Continuity of operations planning

**NOTE:** The standards and procedures set forth herein are intended to establish operational guidelines for community supervision agencies operating through the board of county commissioners and their employees/contractors and the juvenile offenders under supervision. They are not intended to establish state created liberty interests for community supervision agencies, or the board of county commissioners, or their employees/contractors, or juvenile offenders, or an independent duty owed by the Kansas Department of Corrections- Division of Juvenile Services to community supervision agencies operating through the board of county commissioners or their employees/contractors, supervised juvenile offenders or third parties. This standard and procedure is not intended to establish or create new constitutional rights or to enlarge or expand upon existing constitutional rights or duties.
