<u>STANDARD</u>: Written policy, procedure and practice shall allow properly trained Community Supervision Agency staff to restrain juveniles for the purposes of public safety, staff safety and/or safety of the juvenile. Staff shall use the least restrictive method to control the situation. Staff who perform this function shall receive restraint training annually. Documentation is required to verify staff has received training.

The following steps shall be required for a Community Supervision Agency to adopt a local policy for utilizing any type of restraint the following steps shall be required:

- Legal review by county or district legal authority
- Inform the Juvenile Corrections Advisory Board (JCAB)
- Approved by all Boards of County Commissioners in the counties where restraints may be utilized
- Submit policy to the Secretary of the Division of Juvenile Services prior to implementation
- Adhere to the procedural guidelines established in the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Manual and adhere to any local policies set forth pertaining to the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act of 2002

<u>DISCUSSION</u>: Community Supervision Agencies that do not utilize restraints do not need a local policy for this Standard.
