Hello Everyone,

I am sure we are all rejoicing at the return of more agreeable weather! I noticed in my email that the annual plant sale is at Topeka Correctional Facility gearing up. This is another sure sign that Spring is finally on its way!

Pathway to Success, our new KDOC strategic plan, has reached the implementation phase. Our Strategic Implementation Teams (SIT) are currently being formed and we will announce membership next week, and meetings will start in late March/early April. SIT teams will bring recommendations to the Core Leadership Team on how to move our strategic goals into actions. You will also start seeing the Pathway to Success logo underneath KDOC email signatures. I hope this is a visual reminder that we are embarking on an exciting new era for our department! We are now in our fourth week of offering COVID-19 vaccinations to staff and residents. We are monitoring progress for resident vaccinations on our website at https://www.doc.ks.gov/kdoccoronavirus-updates/covid-19-vaccinations. Electronic Messaging with GTL: KDOC has updated the electronic communication process for our residents. The contractor is ICS Corrections, Inc., so you may see that name from time to time. GTL replaces Jpay as the banking and e-communication solution for our residents. All facilities are connected to the new service and tablets are available. The multi-user Kiosks are still being installed at some locations. Residents can use the Kiosks or GTL tablets to send and receive messages, check bank balances, order commissary (inmate phone ordering will continue), and make changes to their PAN list. Tablets will be checked out and checked in according to facility rules. Currently, KDOC provides a ratio of one tablet for every four residents.

Please note: Families and loved ones will still use Jpay to deposit funds in the resident's trust account for use within the facility. However, to send electronic mail and content to a resident, families and loved ones will use https://www.gettingout.com/messages-photos/
