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NOTICE OF REVOCATION

IMPP 04-113 - This IMPP was originally issued on 07-21-98. Following the consolidation of the Kansas Department of Corrections and the Juvenile Justice Authority pursuant to Executive Reorganization Order No. 42, a review of this policy showed that its provisions are no longer relevant as the federal military surplus program is now known as the 1033 program and requires formal application by the Department for participation. Procurement of any surplus items would continue to be made in accordance with IMPP 04-116D, Purchasing. Further, in Section II. of this policy, the Defense Reutilization and Marketing Services (DRMS) property guidelines are now governed by the Kansas Department of Administration Office of Surplus Property, who is the State Coordinator, that requires any law enforcement agency wishing to participate to sign a Memorandum of Understanding that outlines the Department's responsibilities. As such, this policy is hereby revoked on 02-12-15.
