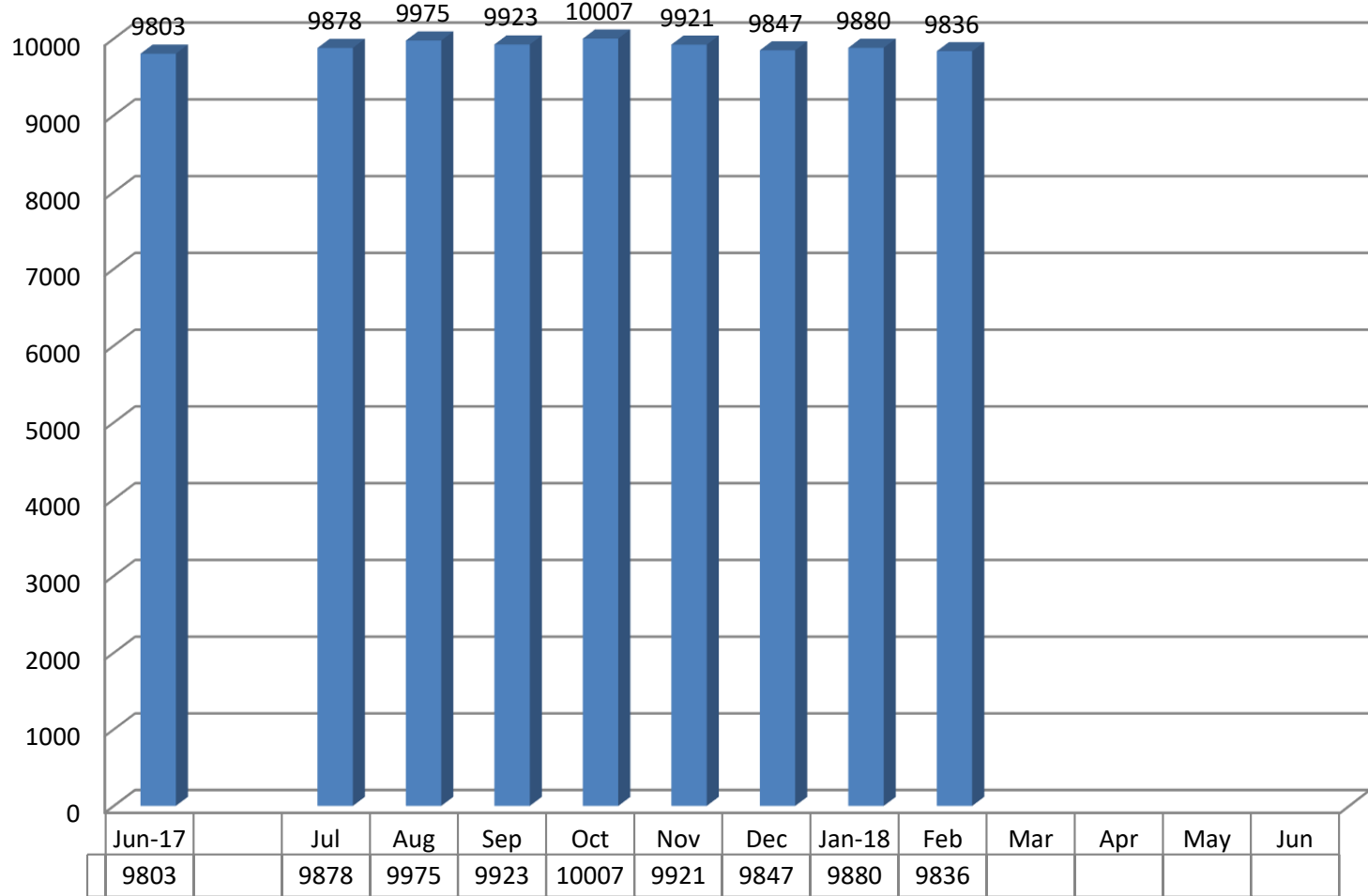

**End-of-Month Inmate Population: FY 2018 To-Date**

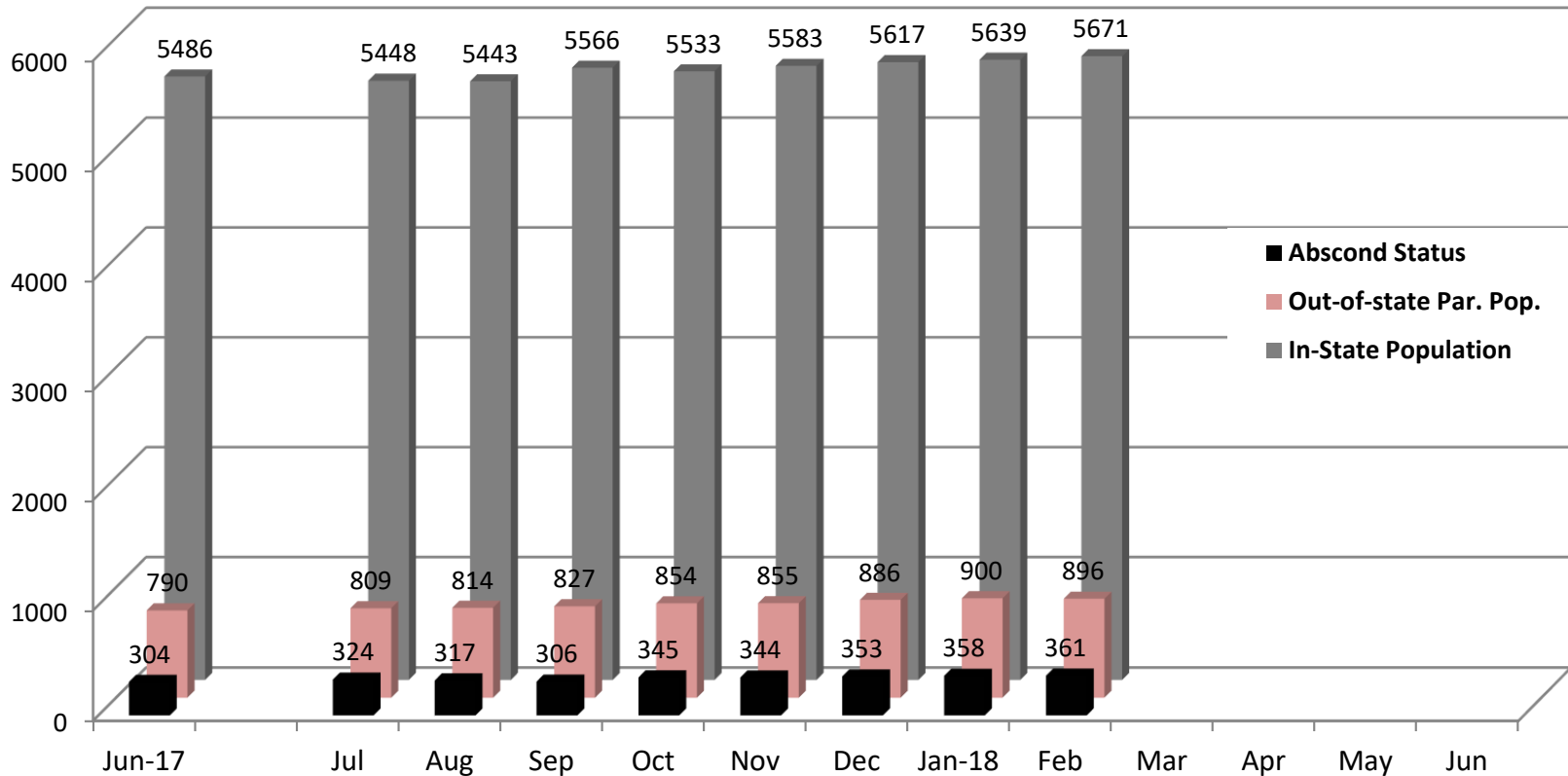

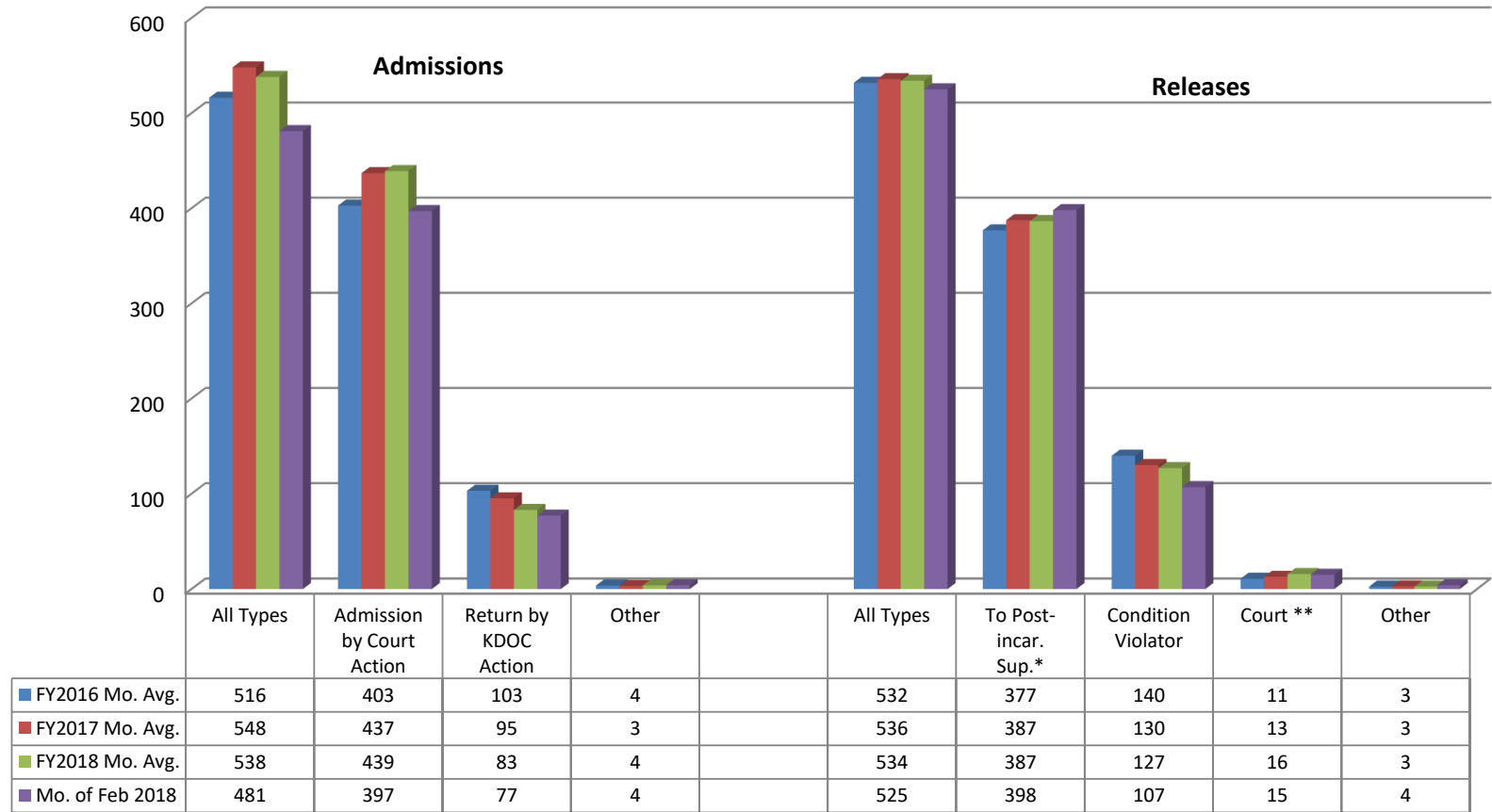

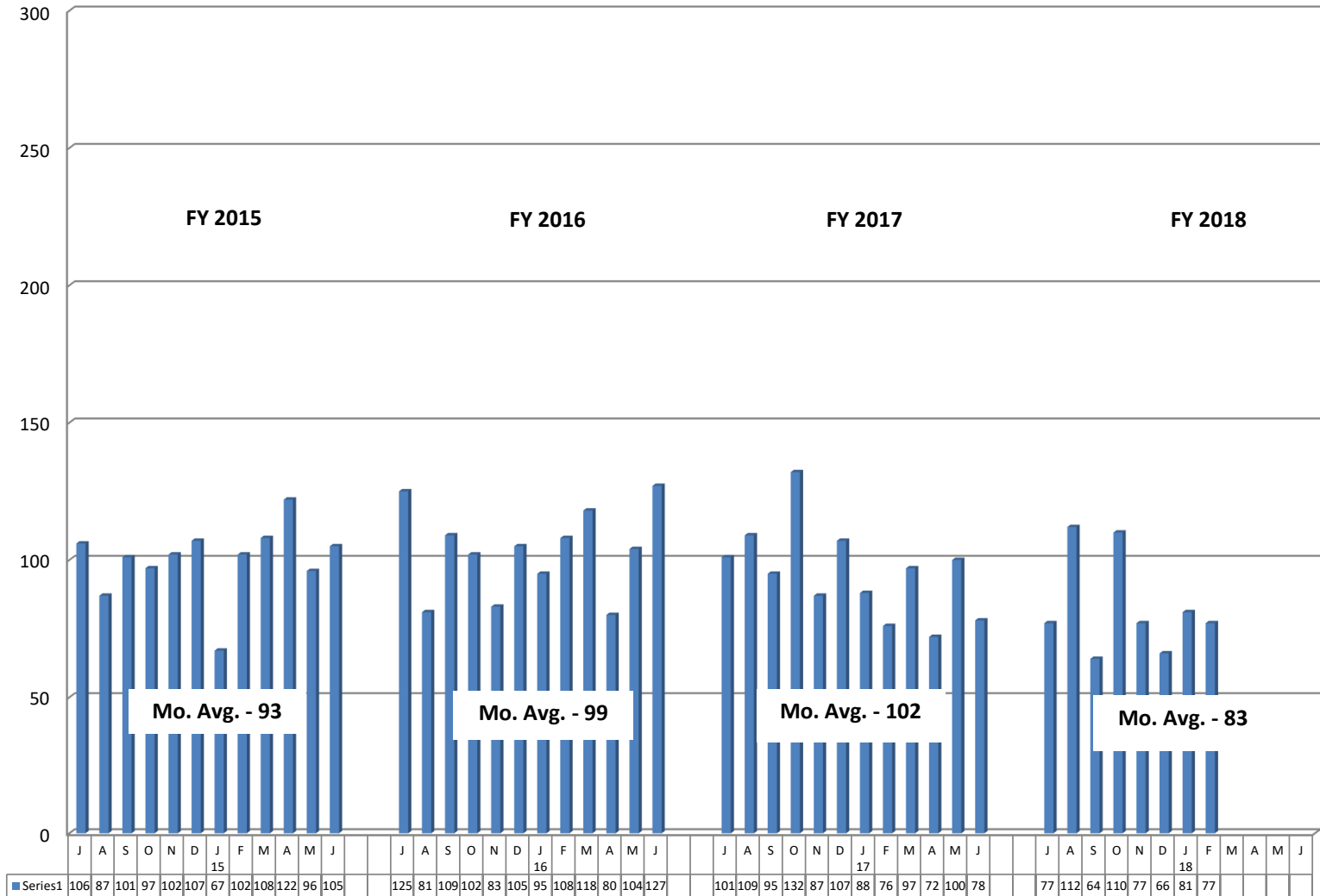
